

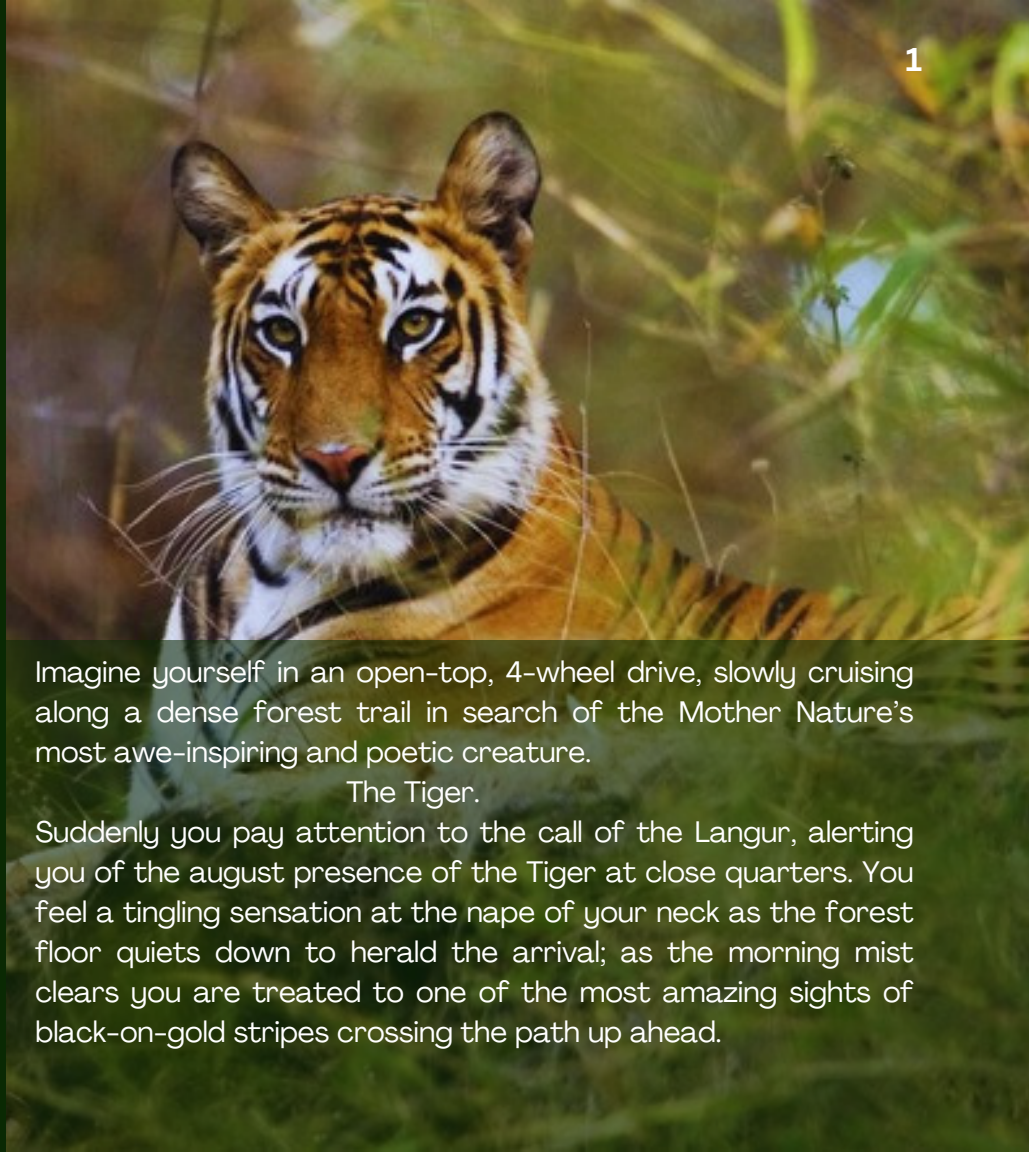

Suddenly you pay attention to the call of the Langur, alerting you of the august presence of the Tiger at close quarters. You feel a tingling sensation at the nape of your neck as the forest floor quiets down to herald the arrival; as the morning mist clears you are treated to one of the most amazing sights of black-on-gold stripes crossing the path up ahead.

Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve, India.

The park derives its name from the most prominent hill of the area, which is said to have been given by Lord Rama to his brother Lakshmana to keep a watch on Lanka (Bandhav = Brother, Garh = Fort). The fort was built by a Gond Dynasty king.

One of the biggest attractions of this national park is the Bengal tiger (*Panthera Tigris*). Bandhavgarh has one of the highest density of tigers known in the world. Over and above that, the reserve is also populated with Spotted Deer, Sambhar, Leopards, Gaur, nilgai, Barking Deer, Wild Boar, wild elephants and the Jackal. With the tiger at the apex of the food chain, it contains at least 37 species of mammals, 350 species of birds, 80 species of butterflies, a number of reptiles. It is also an Ornithologist's dream come true with the a huge collection of birds in the wild.

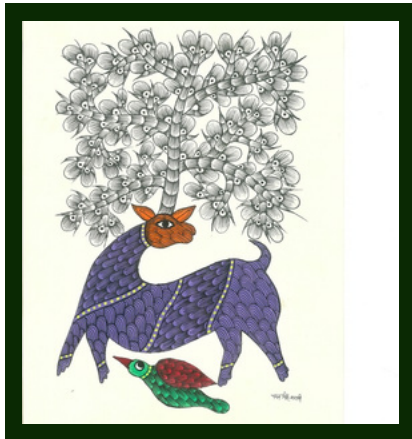
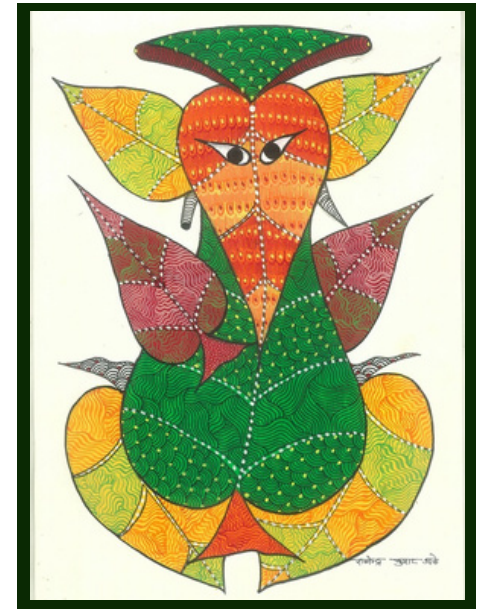
Jangarh Singh Shyam

A Gond Art Legend and Symbol of the Struggle of Indigenous Artists

One of the largest and oldest tribes in India, the Gonds are well known for their vibrant artworks, through which they narrate intriguing stories. The flagbearer of Gond art and the figure behind the popularity that the art form enjoys today, Jangarh Singh Shyam is celebrated as the first Adivasi artist to gain widespread acclaim. Hailing from Patangarh, Madhya Pradesh, he propelled Gond art into international recognition and is credited with creating a new school of Indian contemporary art called the 'Jangarh Kalam.' One of the first Gond artists to use acrylic on paper and canvas, Jangarh's incredible talent evoked great admiration and awe, his untimely passing leaving a gaping void in the world of Indian art. GOND (INDIAN TRIBAL) ART BY JANGARH SINGH SHYAM (1962–2001) was a pioneering contemporary Indian artist credited with being the creator of a new school of Indian art called Jangarh Kalam. His work has been exhibited widely the world over including Bhopal, Delhi, Tokyo and New York. His most notable exhibitions include the Magiciens de la terre in Paris (1989) and Other Masters curated by Jyotindra Jain at the Crafts Museum, New Delhi (1998). His 1988 piece Landscape with Spider sold for \$31,250 at Sotheby's, New York, in 2010—a first for an adivasi artist. Jangarh had also painted the interiors of the Legislative Assembly of Madhya Pradesh, the Vidhan Bhavan, and the dome of Bhopal's Bharat Bhavan—one of the most prestigious museums of tribal and contemporary Indian art. He was among the first Gond artists to use paper and canvas for his paintings, thereby inaugurating what is now known as Jangarh Kalam.

- Khitauli Core Zone - 15 Kms from the Lodge,
- Dhamokar Buffer Zone – 23 Kms from the Lodge
- Panpatha Buffer Zone – 27 Kms from the Lodge
- Johila Buffer Zone – 35 Kms from the Lodge

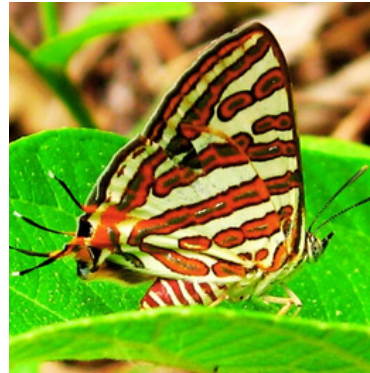
